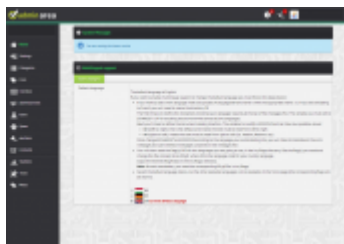


Multilingual Support

Default language

- The default language is English.

- If you want to enable multilingual support or change the default language you must follow the steps below:
- If you want to add a new language make a duplicate of language/EN and name it with the appropriate name: i.e. if you are translating to French you will need to name the directory FR
- The first thing is to define the characters encoding your language requires at the top of the messages file. The variable you must edit is \$CHARSET. UTF-8 encoding should work with almost all the languages.
- Next you'll have to define the document reading direction. The variable to modify is \$DOCDIR and can have two possible values:
 - ltr (left-to-right): this is the default and means the text must be read from left to right
 - rtl (right-to-left): means the text must be read from right to left (i.e. Arabian, Hebrew, etc)
- Once changed \$CHARSET and \$DOCDIR according to the language you are translating into, you will have to translate all the error messages and user interface messages contained in the messages file.
- You will then need the flag(s) GIFs for the languages you are going to use, in the inc/flags directory. Get the flag(s) you need and change the file name(s) to be XX.gif, where XX is the language code for your country language.
- Copy the renamed  flag file(s) in the inc/flags/ directory.

Note: for each translation, you need the corresponding XX.gif file in inc/flags/

- All the other available languages will be available in the home page (the corresponding flags will be shown).
