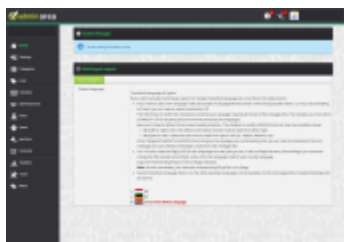


English Cookies Policy

  <strong>What are cookies?</strong></p>
<p>
  Cookies are small text files which a website may put on your computer or
  mobile device when you first visit a site or page. The cookie will help the
  website, or another website, to recognise your device the next time you
  visit. Web beacons or other similar files can also do the same thing. We use
  the term "cookies" in this policy to refer to all files that
  collect information in this way.</p>

  There are many functions cookies serve. For example, they can help us to
  remember your username and preferences, analyse how well our website is
  performing, or even allow us to recommend content we believe will be most
  relevant to you.</p>

  Certain cookies contain personal information – for example, if you
  click to "remember me" when logging in, a cookie will store your
  username. Most cookies won't collect information that identifies you,
  and will instead collect more general information such as how users arrive
  at and use our websites, or a user's general location.</p>

What sort of cookies do YourSiteName use?

"Functionality Cookies"

We use functionality cookies to allow us to remember your preferences. For example, cookies save you the trouble of typing in your username every time you access the site, and recall your customisation preferences, such as which regional edition of the website you want to see when you log in.

Can a user block cookies?

As we've explained above, cookies help you to get the most out of our websites.

The first time you accessed our website after 22 May 2012, you should have seen an overlay which explained that by continuing to access our site, you are consenting to our use of cookies.

However, if you do wish to disable our cookies then please follow the instructions bellow.

Please remember that if you do choose to disable cookies, you may find that certain sections of our website do not work properly.
